KNOW THE SYMPTOMS

Symptoms can be subtle and different for everyone. If you notice any changes that last for more than 3 weeks, visit your GP.



Unusual vaginal bleeding
(e.g. between periods, after sex or after menopause)



Persistent bloating or pelvic pain



Changes in bladder or bowel habits



Loss of appetite or feeling full quickly



Unexplained weight loss



Ongoing tiredness

EARLY DIAGNOSIS SAVES LIVES

The earlier a gynaecological cancer is found, the more treatment options are available and the better the chances of a successful outcome.



Attend your cervical screening when invited (ages 25–64).



Don't ignore persistent symptoms.



Speak to your GP about any concerns, even if they seem small.



Know your family history and risk factors.

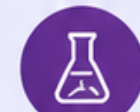


SUPPORT RESEARCH
